CHILD MARRIAGE HAS PROFOUND AND LASTING EFFECTS ON GIRLS' MENTAL HEALTH. RESEARCH SHOWS GIRLS MARRIED BEFORE AGE 18 ARE TWICE AS LIKELY OR MORE TO EXPERIENCE DEPRESSION AND EMOTIONAL DISTRESS COMPARED TO THEIR PEERS.


