Job summary: Clinical Officer (**Maternity Reliever**) is responsible for providing clinical services at Kakenya Health & Wellness Centre (KHWC) and outreach programs/activities. The individual undertakes medical consultations to patients providing treatment within the scope of his/her medical competencies and referring them when appropriate, according to establishing professional and internal protocols, procedures and the universal hygiene standards in order to guarantee quality and efficiency of the service provided.

Location: Kakenya Health & Wellness Centre (KHWC) located in Isampin, Transmara West, Narok County.

Reports to: Clinical Officer in Charge and Administrator.

Supervises: None.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Conduct appropriate clinical assessment and prescription of treatment to all our patients with the highest level of professionalism.
2. Effective referral of patient with cases requiring specialized or/and advanced care.
3. Provide healthcare services to KD patients with highest standards of clinical quality, and in compliance with the Kenya clinical guidelines and protocols.
4. Attend and participate in CMEs and training of staff whenever called upon.
5. Provide health education to Kakenya's Dream school girls whenever assigned.
6. Carry out medical and minor surgical procedures as per the guidelines.
7. Ensure the clinic treatment rooms are well equipped with necessary equipments and supplies at all times.

8. Cover the clinic during weekends and attend to emergency cases at night when on call.
9. Ensure all patients records are properly documented in the patient data system and uphold patient confidentiality at all times.
10. Participate in monthly program outreach activities as assigned.
11. Uphold and promote the core principles and practices of Infection Prevention and Control and medical waste management.
12. Ensure efficient and effective use of resources.
13. Perform any other duties and responsibilities which may be assigned by Supervisor from time to time.
